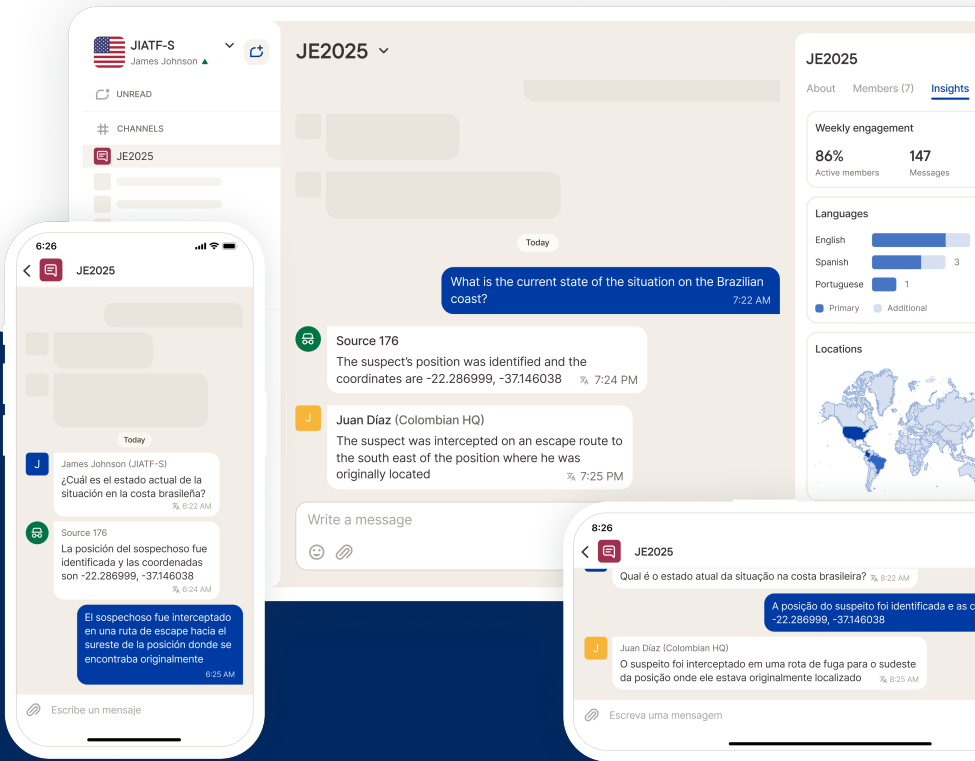

Problem

Military organizations confront significant challenges in polylingual communications, pivotal for operational success in multinational collaborations. The current limitations in communications, where operational efficiency is dependent on the availability of personnel fluent in foreign languages or translators, introduce considerable bottlenecks. These bottlenecks not only decelerate decision-making but also increase operational risks, confining communications to sequential and less secure channels.

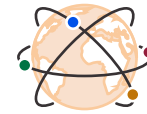

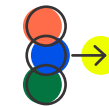

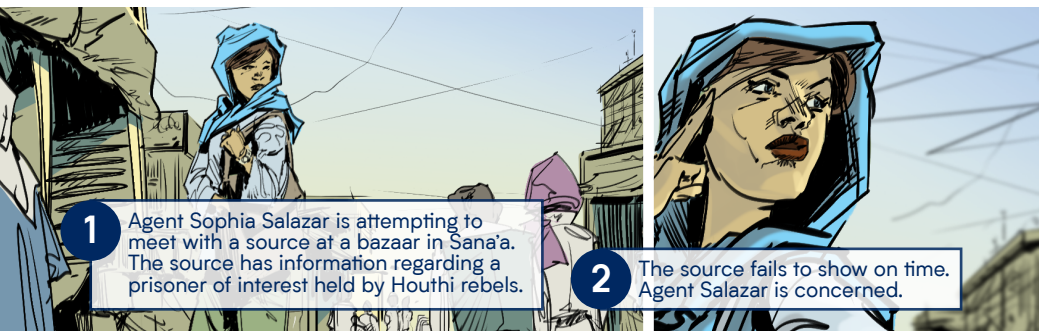

2 The source fails to show on time. Agent Salazar is concerned.



5 Agent Salazar sees the message in English. She responds with a new location. She sets this message to expire 5 seconds after it's read.

6 After the source confirms, Agent Salazar permanently deletes the entire exchange and heads to the meet location.



4 He enters his message in Arabic, informing Salazar that he was followed and must change the meet location. The encryption and ability to anonymize messages make Native ideal for fieldwork.
